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### CONFIGURING THE STAR PICK LIST (FLAT FILE) SERVICE

With the release of GM EPC 4 and new Global EPC(s), this (STAR Standard) file will be written by a service built into the EPCs. There is no need for a separate Parts Writer configuration.

To setup the service:

- Go to Integration Setup, select BDDI Shopping List, and the following Window will appear.
- Select the "File" radio button.

# **CONFIGURING PARTS WRITER**

For ProQuest's Legacy EPCs, we use the standard ProQuest Parts Writer to output a text file to the PCs local hard drive. AutoSoft picks up that file and imports it where required. You'll see how in the workflow demonstration area of this document.

# **CONFIGURING AUTOSOFT**

No additional setup is required in AutoSoft DMS.

# **TRANSFERRING PARTS**

Click the **Send** button in the EPC shopping List to transfer parts to AutoSoft. The parts will be sent to the DMS listed in the "Send To" field. Use the field's drop-down menu to select a different session.

### WORKFLOW FOR AUTOSOFT

To import the shopping list in AutoSoft DMS, do the following.

- 1. Click **Parts** on the AutoSoft DMS main menu.
- 2. Click **Parts Queries** on the Parts Inventory menu.
- 3. Click Load List on the Parts Queries screen.
- 4. Click **Star/AMDSG** on the Saved Lists screen.
- 5. In the list, click the shopping list you transferred to AutoSoft DMS.
- 6. Once you select the list, the screen will display a list of parts on the list.
- 7. Click Select.
- 8. When prompted to indicate if you want to delete the list, click Yes or No.
- 9. The list fills in on the Parts Queries screen. Use the **Dump To** button to dump the list to a counter slip, repair order, the order que, a customer quote, or a purchase order.

#### **COMMON ERRORS**

#### The Shopping List Does Not Exist

This error occurs when no list exists in the AutoSoft DMS system. Verify you transferred the shopping list.
