


KIA Integration Setup


KIA Parts Interface

Communications Setup

Each of the interfaces (Parts, Warranty, RDR) has a link to a common setup screen for communications with WebDCS. Here, the dealership administrator can enter the information that will be used to authenticate the AutoSoft software to WebDCS. This information is stored in the DMS database using an encrypted file format.
